



Dear Swan Point Cemetery Community,

We, like all of you, are closely monitoring the COVID-19 Pandemic. Swan Point is taking all precautionary measures to protect the members of our community and staff while still carrying out our essential roles as a place to bury the dead and provide comfort and inspiration to the living.

Most importantly, our grounds remain open to the public between 8 AM and 5 PM each day. Beginning April 1 the grounds will remain open until 7 PM. The Cemetery is a much-needed green space, offering a place of retreat and reflection, and we do hope that you will continue to feel comfort in our landscape in this time of uncertainty.

While our grounds remain open to the public, we are now taking more measures to protect our staff, visitors, clients, and families. **Our Reception Rooms, Chapels and Administrative Offices will remain closed to the general public until further notice. The kiosk located in the vestibule of the main office building is also available to assist you in locating the deceased. Our public restrooms will also be closed until the spread of the virus is contained.**

We intend to continue performing our most essential business activities, providing burial and cremation services. Our staff will also be available, by appointment, to assist families with the purchase of burial space if a death has occurred or is imminent. Until further notice, we will not be scheduling pre-need sales appointments. In accordance with the call for more social distancing, we have also suspended the use of our chapels for memorial services.
