We are still endeavoring to take all precautionary measures to protect the members of our community and staff while carrying out our essential roles as a place to bury the dead and provide comfort and inspiration to the living.

We are pleased to announce that the cemetery grounds are open to the public. The gates will remain open from 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM each day to allow visitation of loved ones and to provide a place to find pleasure in the beauty and peacefulness of nature.

Our Chapels have reopened and will accommodate a maximum of 25 attendees. Our Gray Coale Reception Hall is available with a maximum cap of 30 guests. Administrative offices remain closed; however, we can assist you by phone or email. Our contact information is 401-272-1314 or services@swanpoint1846.com. The kiosk located in the vestibule of the main office building is also available to assist you in locating the deceased.

We continue to perform our most essential business activities, providing burial and cremation services. Our staff remains available, by appointment, to assist families with the purchase of burial space if a death has occurred or is imminent. We are now scheduling in-person pre-need sales appointments; however, if you prefer to make pre-need arrangements online, this process can be accomplished with photo sharing, email communication with our family counselor and E-invoicing. Office visits require an appointment and face coverings are mandatory.

When visiting the cemetery, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet
- Limit gathering size
- Wear a face covering of cloth as directed by Governor Raimondo's Executive Order 20-30
- Use extra caution when driving
- Adhere to Swan Point's speed limit of 15 mph
- Yield to pedestrians

On behalf of the entire staff I'd like to offer a sincere thank you for all of your efforts in helping us continue with our operations during this difficult time. I am sorry for any inconvenience our restrictions have caused.
